Congratulations on your pregnancy! We share your excitement about this special event in your life. The Women's Center is designed to educate and prepare expectant moms for pregnancy, labor and delivery, and caring for newborns. We offer the tools and knowledge you need, the care and support you want, and the special attention you will appreciate to feel comfortable and confident at every stage.

We'll help to make your baby's birthday special, and your pregnancy and birthing experience memorable. You can count on our staff to help make this experience exceptional for your baby and your family – right from the beginning.

### Designed for Comfort, Enhanced with Technology

Our maternity area is designed with your comfort in mind. Tastefully furnished Labor, Delivery, Recovery (LDR) rooms are equipped with special beds designed to convert to different positions as labor progresses. A specially trained mother/baby nurse cares for you and your baby's needs.

During your stay, you will receive detailed instructions on how to care for yourself and your newborn. After your delivery, a certified lactation consultant will assist with breastfeeding information and a pediatrician will examine your newborn and answer any questions or concerns you might have.

The Women's Center is equipped with the HUGS infant security system to provide a safe and secure environment for you and your baby. Visitors are required to check in with the security guard at the Women's Center

During your mother/baby stay, you and your partner will receive a special meal to celebrate your delivery along with a commemorative birth certificate.

Our goal is to help parents transition into their new role as smoothly as possible. We are here to teach, provide support and care for you and your newborn. From our family to yours, thank you for choosing The Women's Center.

### Childbirth Class

Our childbirth preparation class is designed to prepare the mother-to-be and her labor companion for the birthing experience.

- Breathing and relaxation
- Pain relief options
- Postpartum care and newborn care

The class will include a maternity orientation to familiarize the patient and their family with the facility and our labor and delivery concept. Classes are held the first Tuesday of every month from 6:30-8:30 p.m. in the Floyd Conference Center (1592 Freedom Boulevard, Florence). ### Breastfeeding Preparation

We are pleased to offer expanded lactation services. Our specially trained lactation consultant is available to assist moms and babies during and after their hospital delivery with their lactation questions.

Additionally, we offer free Breastfeeding Preparation classes the second Tuesday of each month from 6:30-8:30 p.m. at The Floyd Conference Center. Registration is required. This class offers consultation in methods to promote lactation and tips for successful breastfeeding experience both during your hospital stay and beyond.

### Maternity Orientation

You and your family are invited to drop by anytime to see our spacious labor and delivery rooms. Learn what education and fitness programs are available for you. An experienced labor and delivery educator will be your host. Walk-ins are welcome for tours. To begin your tour, come to the labor and delivery entrance of The Women's Center.

### Newborn Care

Newborn care is taught during your hospital stay. Our specially trained nursing staff will work diligently to make sure you feel comfortable caring for your baby.

### New Mom Support Group

The New Mom Support Group is a fitness program designed for new moms and their children. Using the hospital's conference center, the program offers an opportunity for new moms to get active and discuss the triumphs and challenges of having a new baby.
